

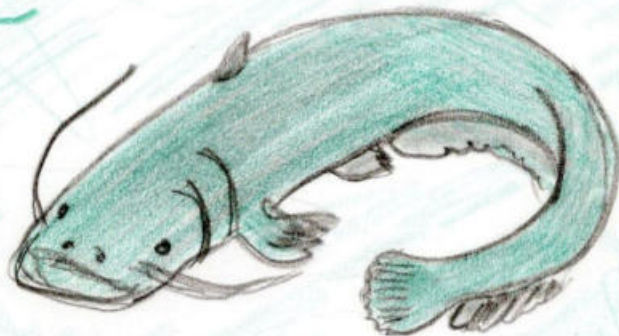

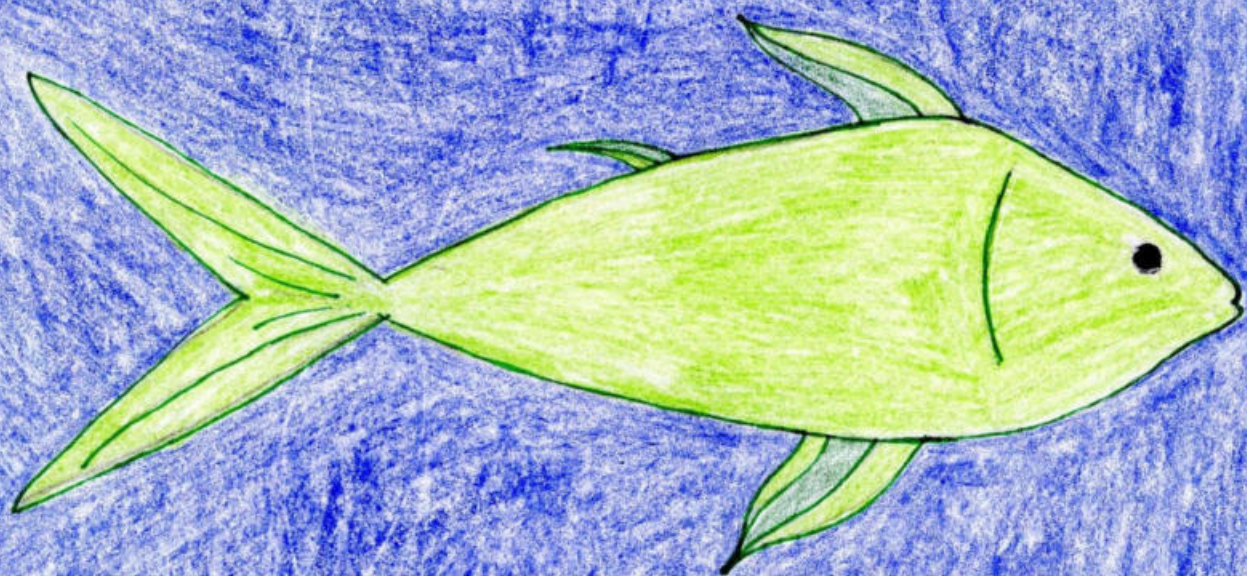

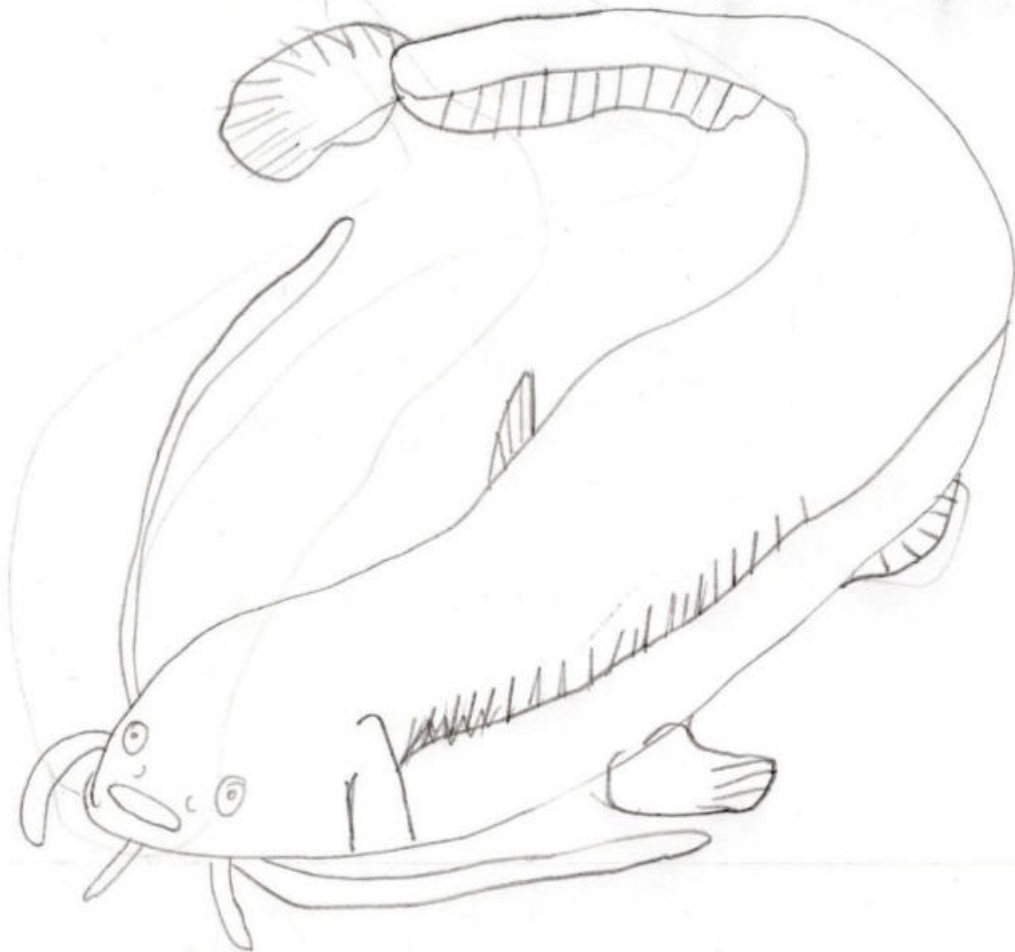


Fishes

They are: 150-200cm long

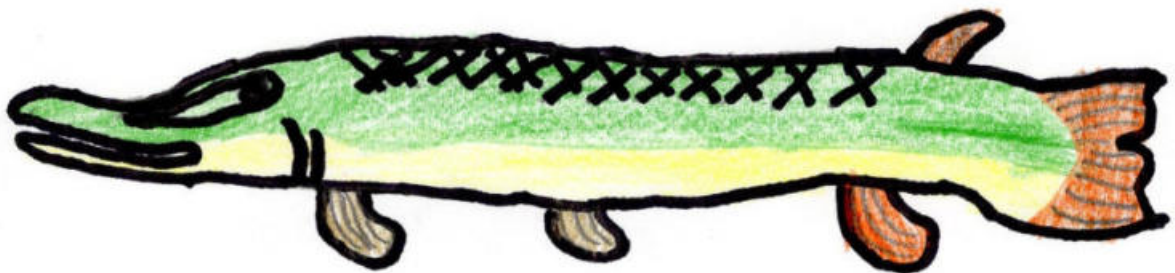
They eat: Amphibians worms

They can: *eat dead animals and ill fishes*

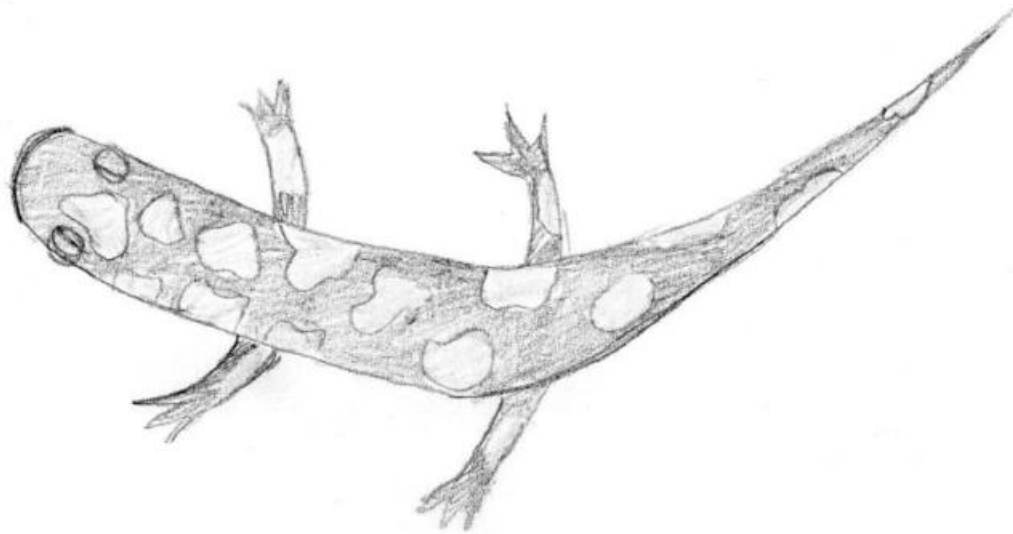

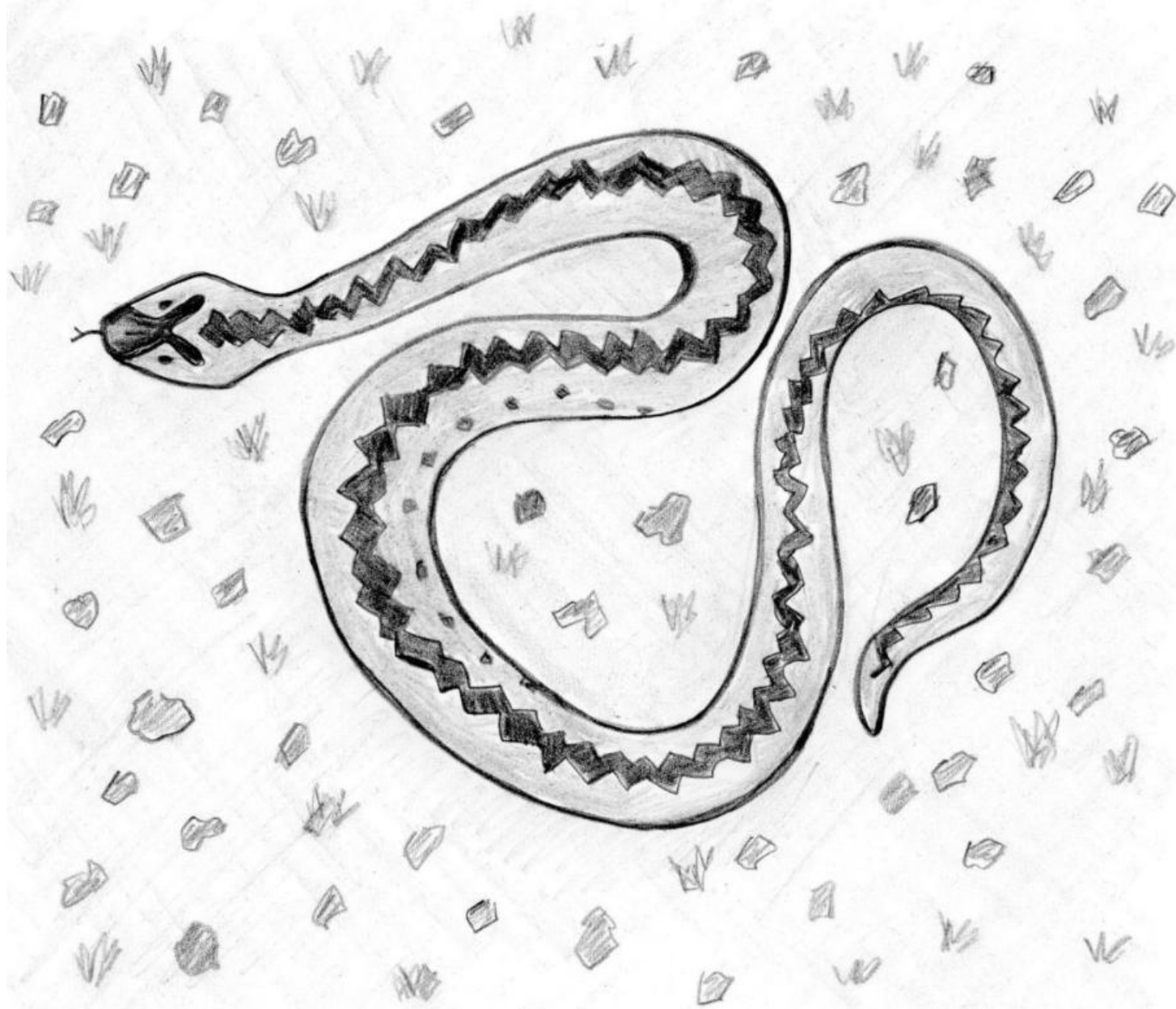
THE TREE FROG

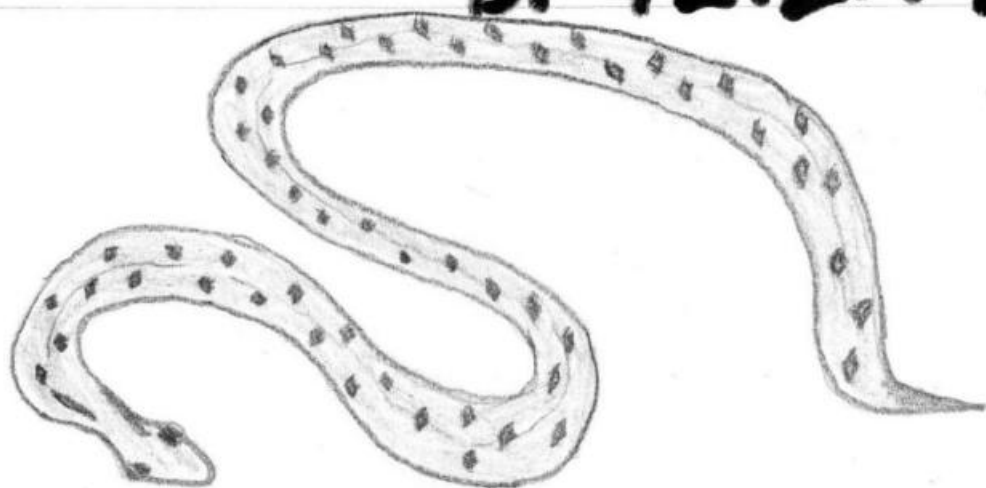

THEY ARE: 40-70 cm long, non-toxic

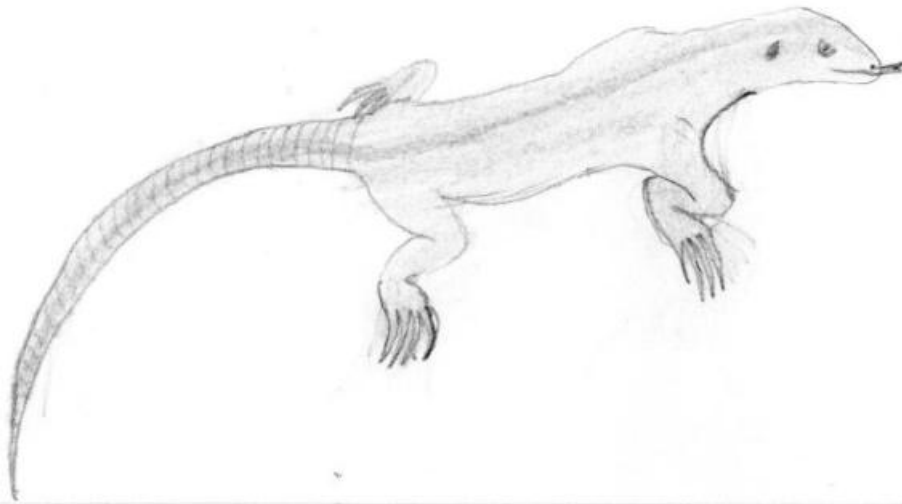
THEY EAT: insects, lizards

They are: 20-25 cm long (and they have very long tail).

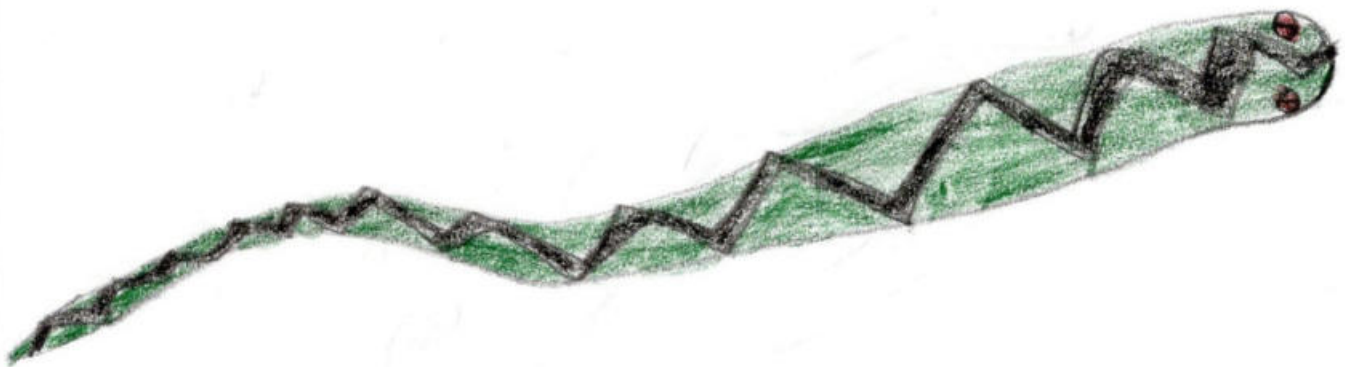
They eat: Insects, spiders, worms, snails.

glade, stony slope, moss

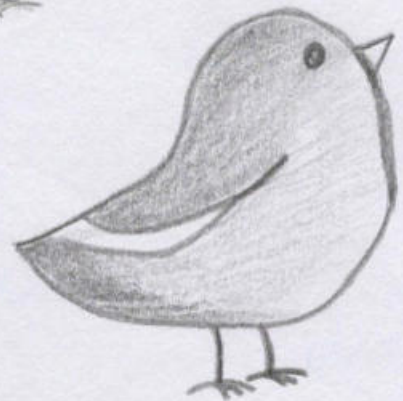
THEY ARE: max 80 cm long, viper male is

(winter sleep)

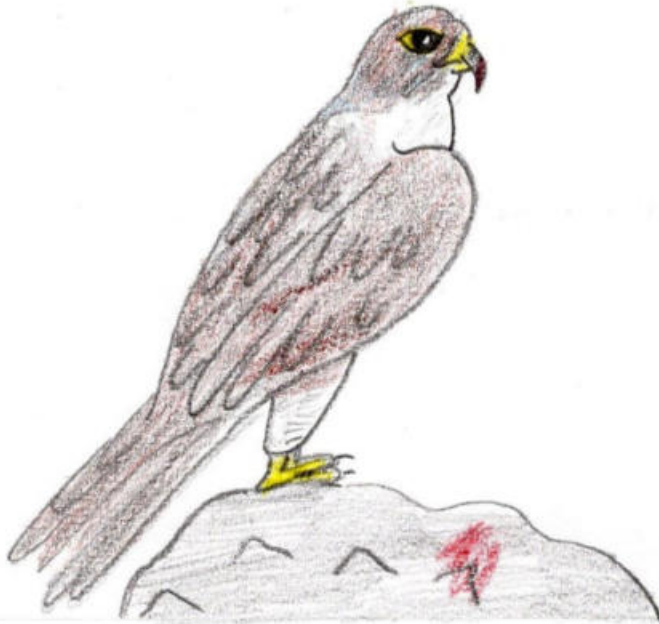

THEY ARE: 35-50 cm body length, 85-115 cm wing span

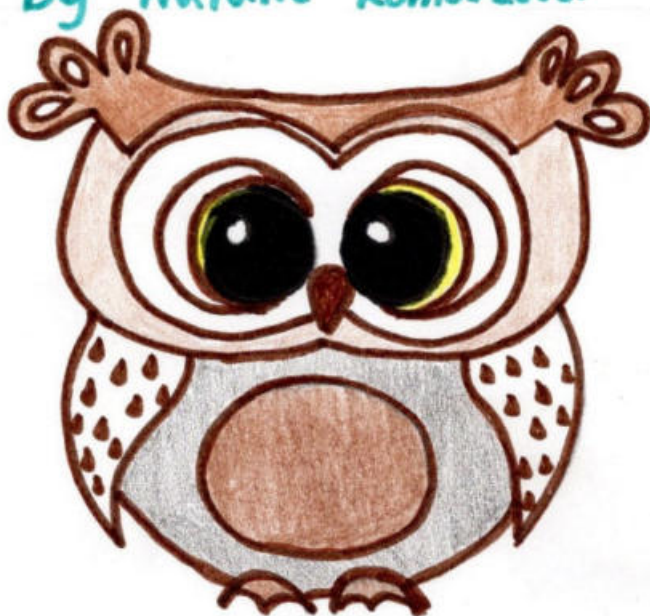
THEY EAT: it feeds on small birds and small mammals

They are: 33-39cm high

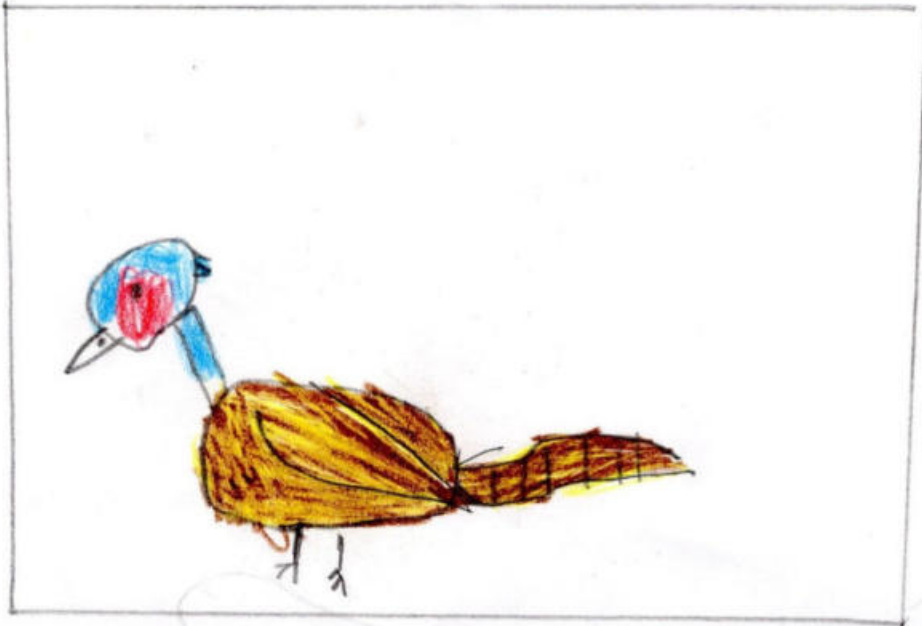
They eat: insects, spiders, earthworms, snails and crabs, fish, reptiles, frogs, birds and small mammals

their wingspan is 180-219 cm

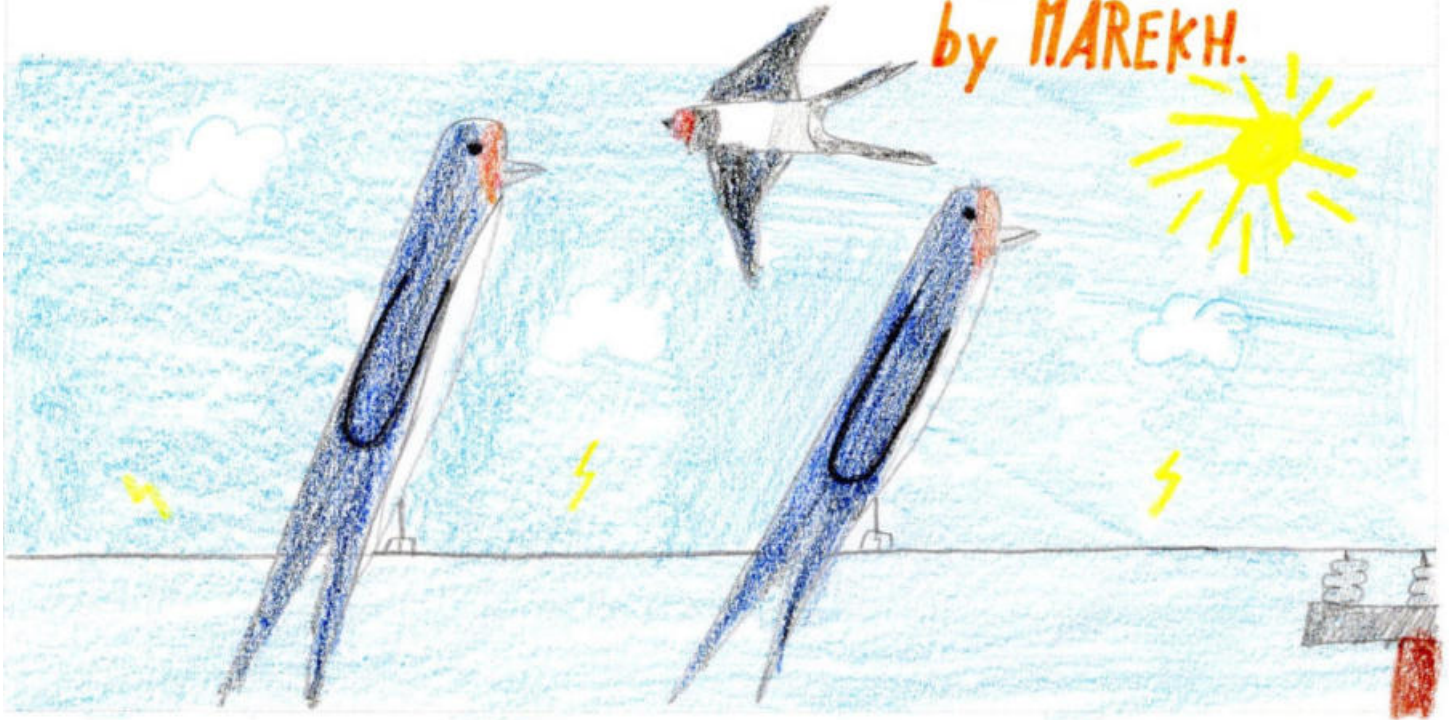
They eat: small mammals,

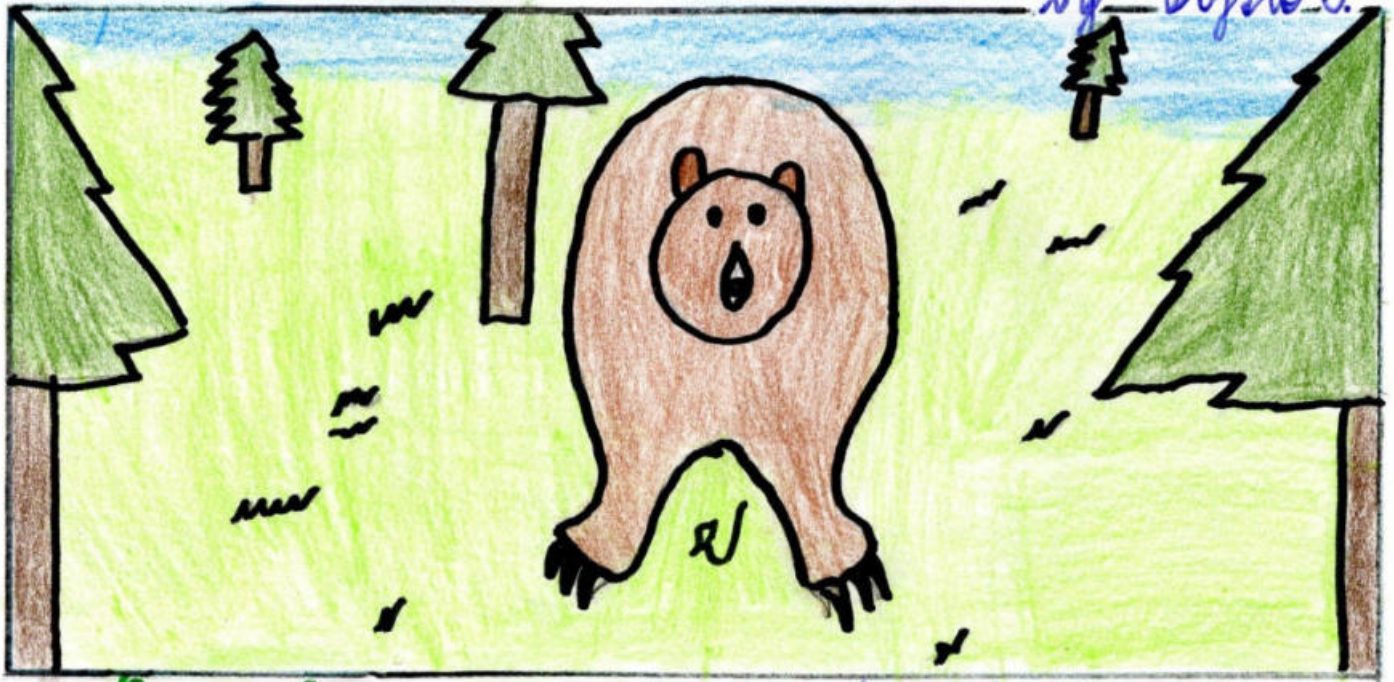

They are: 90 - 135 cm long with tail

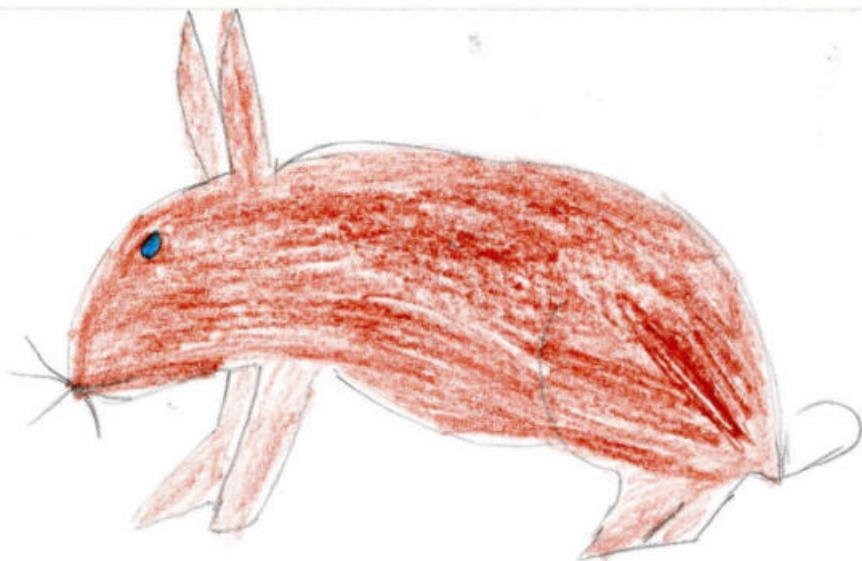
They eat: mice, fawns, hares, frogs, ducks, hens
