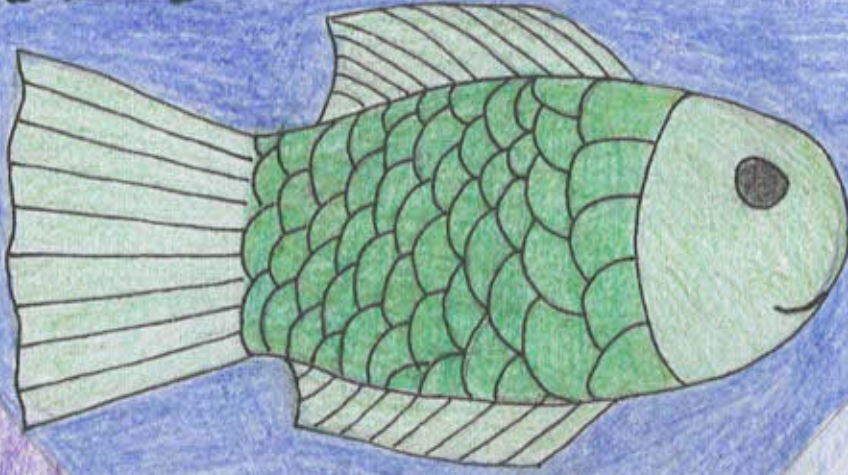

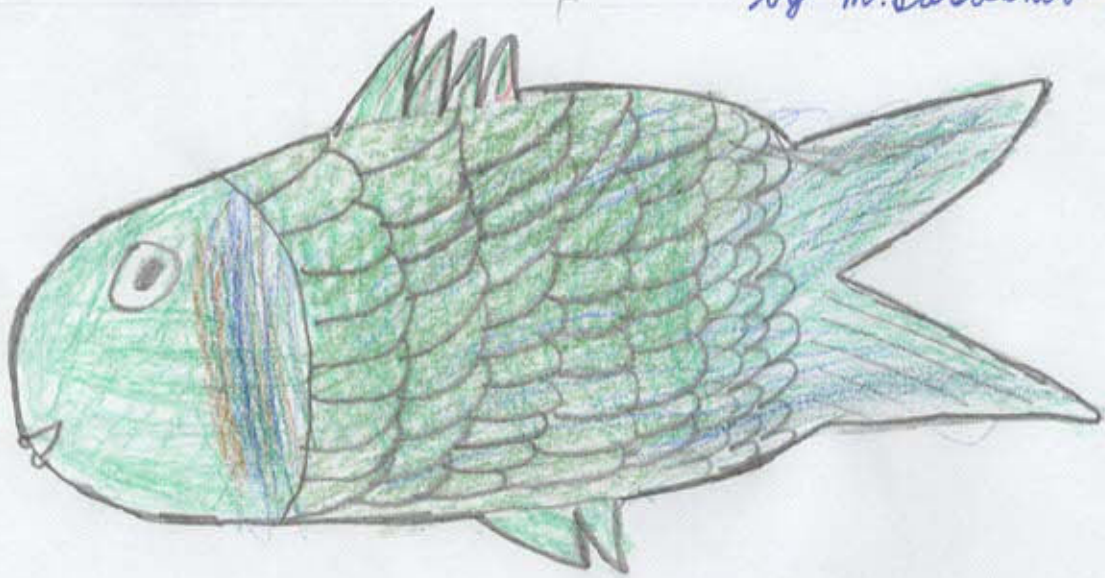

They eat: insect

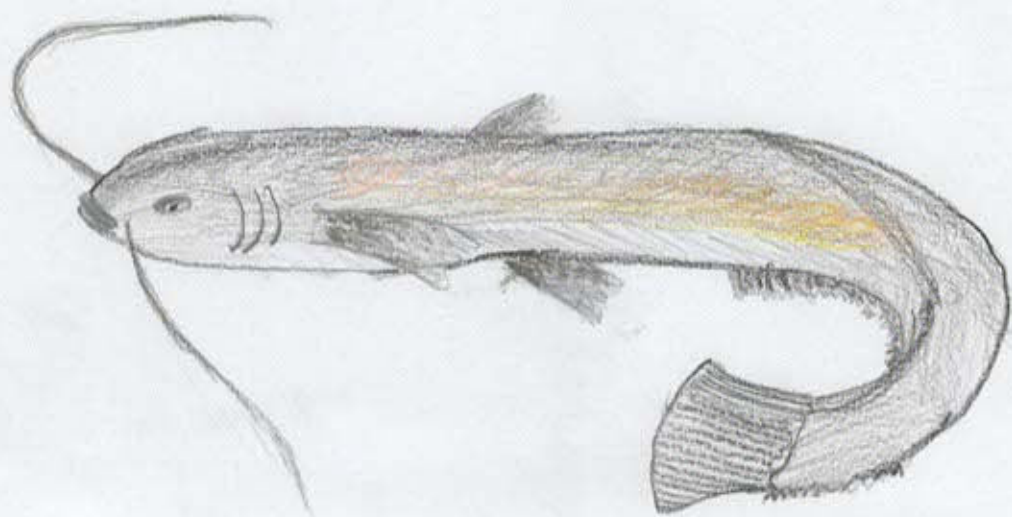
They can: swim, dig

They can: be very agile, fast and predatory

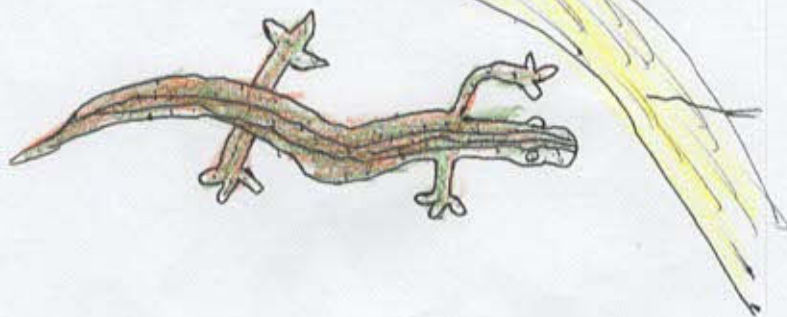

THE TREE FROGS

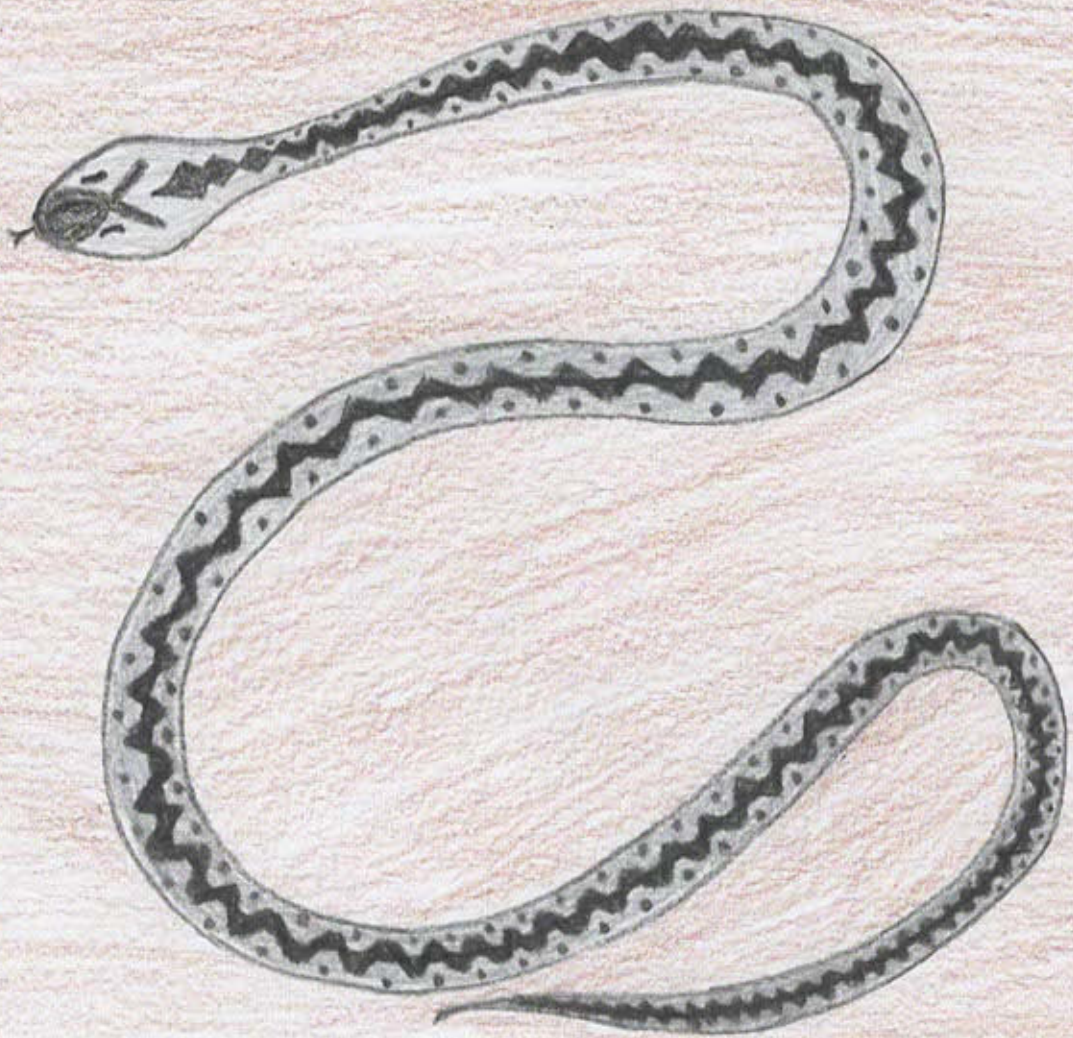

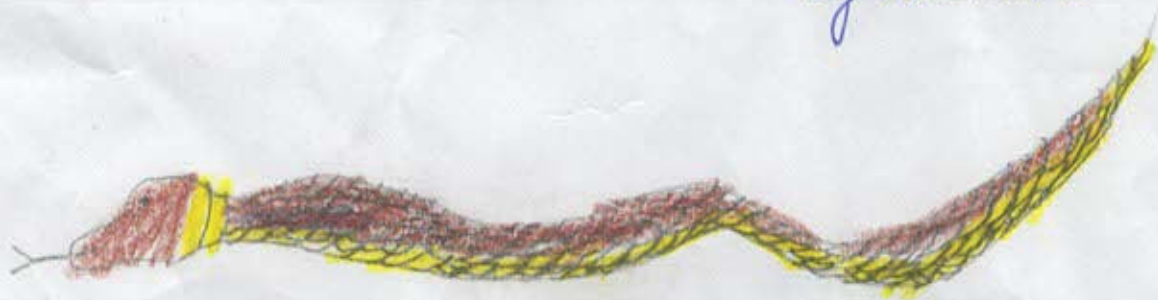

They are: 20 - 25 cm long

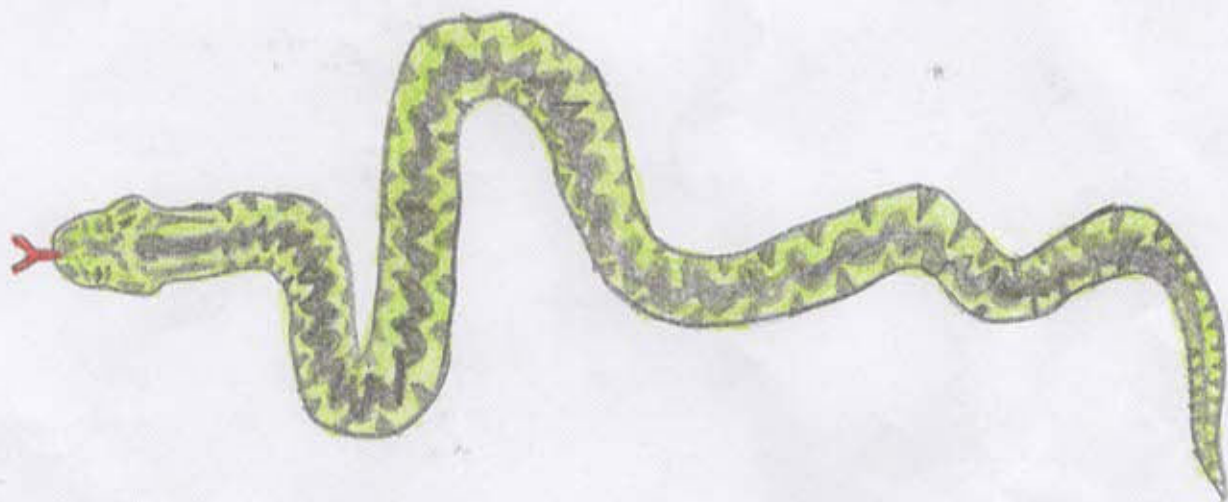
They eat: insect, worms and spiders

They are: 75-90cm long

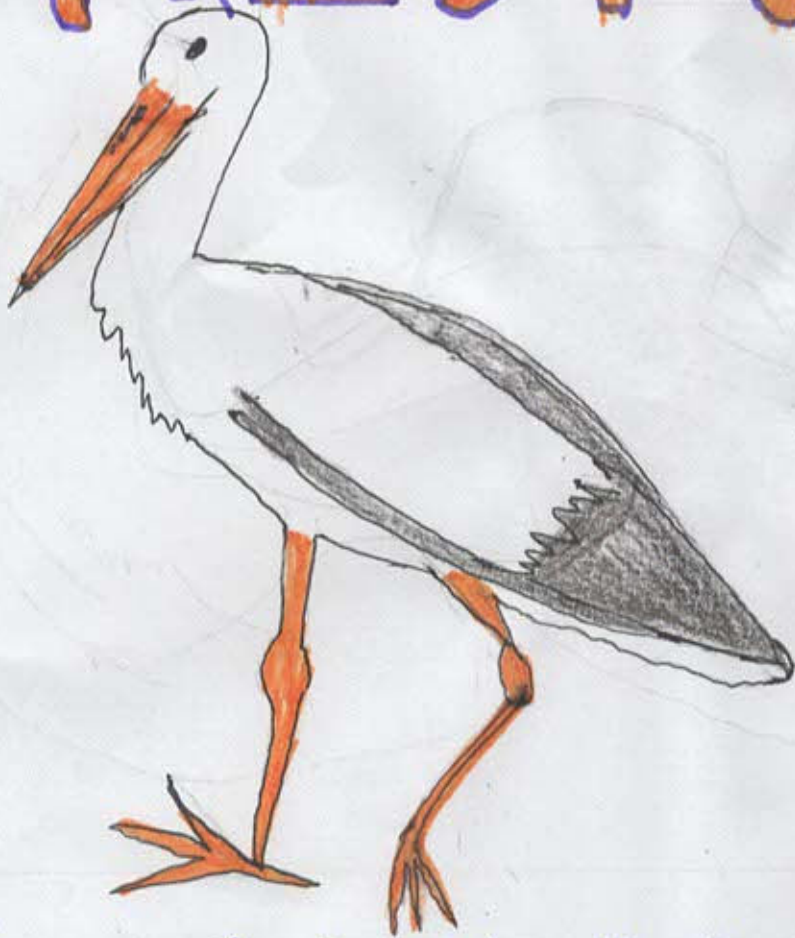
They eat: insects and parts of plants

They are: about 13 cm long

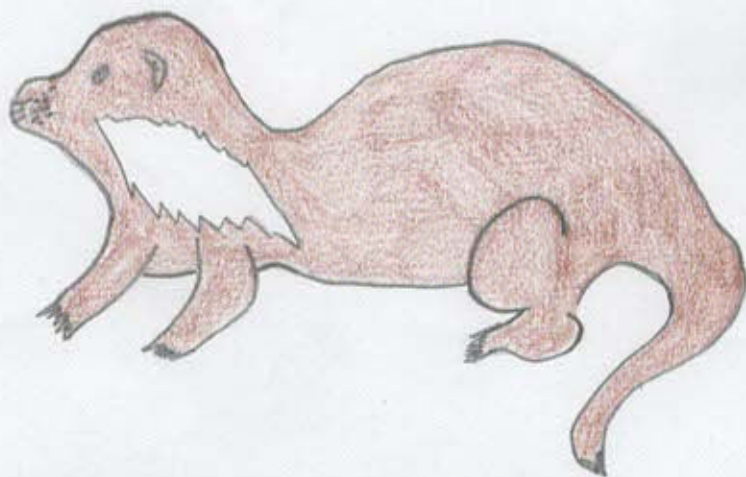
They eat: insects, earthworms, lizards, frogs, mice

They are - 90-135 cm long and weigh 7-14 kg.

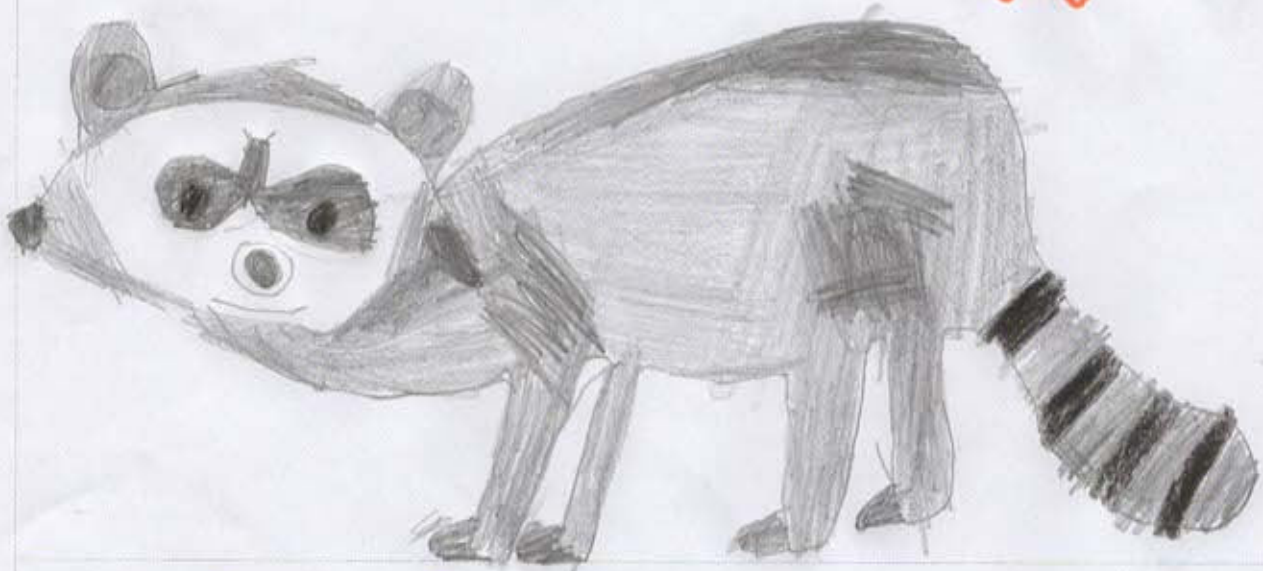
They eat - tiny fish, voles and insects.
